The **SMART Cebu** (SMEs for Accountability, Responsibility and Transparency) project is implementing a three year program in Cebu that is aiming to increase the competitiveness of SMEs in three main sector associations supported by the European Chamber of Commerce (ECCP) in Cebu:

- Cebu Furniture Industries Foundation (CFIF)
- Gifts Toys and House Ware Association (GTH)
- ► Fashion Accessories Manufacturers Association (FAME)

The Nucleus approach was launched and introduced to entrepreneurs and their Business Membership Organizations (BMOs) in June. representatives from the Cebu business community, members of the press and other stake holders participated. The Printers Nucleus in Ampara wanted to follow a training program on Graphic Designing. The program was conducted for them by a

member of the Computer Nucleus in Kandy who they met at the Nucleus Cricket Fest that was held in March this year. One of the primary objectives of the Nucleus Entrepreneur Exchange supported by GTZ FLICT is the promotion of inter regional business linkages between groups. This is one such example where cross regional business linkages have been established as a result of project interventions and activities that are mutually advantageous for groups across the regions.



We asked one of the most reputed training providers in the Graphic Designing field about conducting this course for the group of printers in Ampara, they said that the group would have to go to Colombo and follow one of their packaged courses. The program that was conducted by E Win networks had the advantage of being designed especially for the Printers, plus that could follow it at a fragment of the cost.

Promotion of Micro Finance through improving access to financial services

The Nucleus Foundation has entered into an agreement with the GTZ ProMIS program to Improve the livelihoods of up to 750 persons in the former conflict regions of Sri Lanka through the promotion of productive and efficient micro enterprises and improving their access to financial services.

The training program for counsellor recruited to work in Jaffna, Vavuniya, Mannar, Batticaloa and Ampara took place in July after which the Counsellors will be deployed in these 5 districts to form Nucleus groups.
